SEA FREIGHT

MAERSK AND MSC UPGRADE ASIA-EUROPE SWEEPER TO A WEEKLY SERVICE

- due to increase in demand and rise in freight rates.
- The new launched sailings mitigates the impact of the temporary suspension of the AE2/Swan loop.
- The rotation is: Shanghai-Ningbo-Yantian-Singapore-Tanjung-Pelepas-PortSaid-Rotterdam-Antwerp-Felixstowe-Tanger Med-Singapore-Ningbo.



OPERATIONS SUSPENDED @JNPCT, MUMBAI

- Strong winds and heavy rain have caused three container cranes to collapse at JNPCT, Mumbai.
- Operations suspended due to bad weather. Operations may get impacted in the coming months too until the surveys and replacements are completed.



GARMENT INDUSTRY: REVIVAL EXPECTED IN QUARTER 4



The Garment industry is set to have a slow re-start post-Covid with a recent survey showing 40% of the Buyers worldwide will continue to cancel or postpone orders until the fourth quarter. Besides Covid, US protectionist trade policies came top of the list of concerns for the third consecutive year.

JNPT EXPECTS NORMAL IMPORTS FROM THIS MONTH-END



- With increase in exports JNPT expects imports to get back to normal from the August end.
- The port handled a total of 196 vessels with the overall traffic handling in July standing at 4.85

million tonnes as against 4.07 million tonnes handled in June'20

SHIPPING ORDERBOOK SHRINKS TO 17-YEAR LOW ON COVID-19 IMPACT

- According to Baltic and International Maritime Council BIMCO Newbuilding orderbook across all ship types has touched its lowest point in 17 years against the pandemic



- September 2003, was the lowest for the orderbook of container shipping segment, but now its fallen by 10.3% the lowest..
- Scarcity of new orders is due to drop in trade volumes and long road to recovery looms.
- Newbuilding deliveries, however, have not been heavily affected by the pandemic. Total deliveries are down 1.7% in the first seven months at 46.4m dwt..

“STRICTLY COMPLY” WITH IMDG CODE WHILE HANDLING DANGEROUS GOODS: DG SHIPPING ADVISES STAKE HOLDERS

- Explosion at The Port of Beirut in Lebanon reportedly caused by the detonation of dangerous goods (ammonium nitrate) which had been stored at the dock since it was offloaded from a cargo ship, leaving several death & injuries



- India's maritime administration has advised Stakeholders (ships, ports, shippers, stevedores and transport operators) to “strictly comply” with the provisions of the International Maritime Dangerous Goods Code (IMDG Code) while handling dangerous goods or hazardous materials to ensure no incidents occur while dealing with dangerous goods on board ships and in ports,”

SPICEJET GETS SLOTS AT LONDON HEATHROW AIRPORT



- Spice Jet has secured the permission to fly to US and UK

with slots at Heathrow from September, will wet-lease an A330 to fly on this route.

- Spicejet ,Indian low cost carrier has cargo credentials and operates freighters between India and Europe which was impacted by the grounding of Jet Airways last year.

COMMUNITY SYSTEMS AND DATA CORRIDORS KEY TO DOOR-TO-DOOR TRANSPARENCY IN AIR CARGO



- The increasing need for air cargo players to develop community systems has resulted in consultancies to develop and initiate a special focus on cargo community systems , data and logistics corridors.
- This provides links between airports allowing participants in the chain to have complete door-to-door transparency and increases in quality and speed.
- Once implemented, sensitive cargos like pharmaceuticals and lithium need no longer have to stay in an airport on arrival, as they can be immediately processed, pre-cleared and pass through airports direct to truck and to the consignee.

COVID VACCINE : LOGISTICAL CHALLENGES IN AIR CARGO DISTRIBUTION



- In modern history of air cargo, experts are warning of logistical challenges for worldwide distribution of Covid-19 vaccine.

- The International Air Cargo Association (Tiaca) and Pharma Aero the two associations are bringing together pharmaceutical manufacturers and logistics players to provide the industry with clarity of the demands and expectations of vaccine supply chains, including requirements for quality control, critical tradelanes, air cargo capacity, handling ,storage with efficient tracking .

VIRGIN ATLANTIC'S CARGO FLIGHTS CONTINUE AS IT APPLIES FOR BANKRUPTCY PROTECTION IN US



- Cargo operations will continue while it goes through the process of securing court approval for its creditor backed restructuring plan.
- Cargo flights will continue between Heathrow and New York, Los Angeles, Shanghai, Hong Kong, Lagos, Miami, Johannesburg, Delhi, Mumbai, Atlanta, Chicago, Dublin, Brussels and Barbados.

INDIAN RAILWAYS ATTRACT CONTAINER TRAIN OPERATORS WITH OFFER OF 5% FREIGHT RATE DISCOUNT.

The offer lacks clarity on the private container train operators (CTOs), who wanted waive off to entire haulage charges on movement of empty containers.

The discounts validity period is from 4th August'2020, till 30th April 2021.

DELHI, MUMBAI CUSTOMS TO START FACELESS CARGO ASSESSMENT FROM AUGUST 3



"Indian Customs has rolled out the 2nd phase of Faceless Assessment at Delhi, Mumbai, Chennai and Bangalore Customs Zones," Mumbai Customs would undertake faceless assessment of items covered under Chapter 29-(Organic chemicals)

ANOTHER BLOW TO CHINA: INDIA TO CUT LOW-QUALITY IMPORTS FROM MARCH 2021

BIS is set to frame quality norms for 371 items by March 2021. These 371 tariff lines include multiple segments, ranging from steel, chemicals, pharmaceuticals, and electrical machinery to furniture and toys.



Many sub-standard and non-essential imports will be stopped from March 2021. As India strives towards self-reliance, imports of many non-essential items will be curbed from March 2021.

EYE ON CHINA, GOVT MULLS DUTY HIKE ON TEXTILES, CAMERAS, LAPTOPS

The government is considering to increase customs duty on approx 20 product segments like laptops, cameras, textiles and aluminium goods, to restrict imports from China. Some steel products may be also restricted by the DGFT.



INDIAN RAILWAYS

has recently send its first-ever export container train to Bangladesh from CONCOR's Container Freight Station (CFS) at Majerhat in Kolkata to Benapole through integrated check post (ICP) at Petrapole.
