Increasing congestion coupled with blanked sailings, equipment and manpower shortages un cleared bookings, backlog ,voided vessel, limited berthing windows lead Carrier, to face space crunch across India, on all trade lanes and services.

BOOM IN INTRA – ASIA TRADE – CARRIERS LAUNCH-ADD ON SERVICES

- MSC** revamps and adds on four additional intra Asia Service to strengthen China Asean Trades
- MSC** launched a new South-east Asia loop, which links Tanjung Pelepas, Singapore, Jakarta, Yantian, Kaohsiung, Manila, Vung Tau and Laem Chabang.
- Maersk** adjusted two intra-Asia strings to add, new direct calls between Indonesia and China
- ONE** line has increased direct sailings from China, with two new services launching this month to Indonesia, Thailand, Vietnam and the Philippines.
- Thailand's **RCL** -Butterfly service between Singapore, Malaysia, and Indonesia
- Wan Hai** will launch its fourth string between Taiwan, Vietnam and Thailand with partner Interasia Lines.

- From Indian ports with effect from August 15th
- Applicable for confirmed bookings where no equipment has been picked up within 7 calendar days to vessel departure.
- Not applicable for bookings to North America destinations on Transpacific Trade, Haz bookings & special equipments including Refrigerated units
- Booking cancellation fee (BCF) tariff will be 25 USD per standard container, any size.

AIR FREIGHT RATES LOOK UP -PASSENGER-FREIGHTERS LEAVE THE MARKET

- End of July'20, rates jump by \$1 per kg from Shanghai to Europe.



- Airlines intimated further increase in rates due to:-

- ▶ Low capacity, weak passenger demand, rising PPE requirements, increase in general cargo.
- ▶ Medium-term expectations show both demand and capacity likely rising.

LATEST FREIGHTER FIRE PROMPTS NEW QUESTIONS ON LITHIUM BATTERY SAFETY

- A fire onboard on Ethiopian Airlines 777 freighter at Shanghai Pudong has triggered questions on the safety of lithium batteries due to Cargo mis declaration.



- Lithium batteries are prohibited on passenger aircraft.
- In spite of strict rules on their carriage on freighters., there have been problems with :-
 - ▶ undeclared counterfeit batteries, poor packaging and mis-declared batteries.
 - ▶ Lithium batteries in modern goods makes the regulations harder to enforce

INDIAN PHARMA COMPANIES EXPORTS 2K TONS PER MONTH VIA TURKISH AIRLINES AMID PANDEMIC



- Pharmaceuticals, top priority during pandemic, the airline carried cargo from the major hubs like Hyderabad, Mumbai, Ahmedabad, Bangalore, and Delhi.

- current uplift contributed to increase in pharmaceutical share from 9.8 % to 26.5%.yoy of turkish airlines
- Garments business were converted to PPE in Bangladesh, Pakistan, India, and Sri Lanka by deploying passenger aircrafts which were specially customized for cabin loading increased market share from 6 % to 14 %.yoy
- In South Asia, it has carried fish from Maldives, nuts of Afghanistan, tea and betel leaves of Sri Lanka and mangoes of India and Pakistan. which increased market share from 5.7 percent to 18.4 percent

The validity for MEIS is until December'20. It is to be replaced with a more WTO-compatible scheme, RoDTEP, which reimburses all levies (that are not subsumed by GST) paid on inputs consumed in exports.

RAILWAYS LOADS SPECIAL PARCEL TRAIN BEYOND COUNTRY'S BORDERS FOR 1ST TIME



For the first time, the Indian Railways loaded a Special Parcel Train beyond the country borders, to Bangladesh with dry chillies from Andhra Pradesh earlier was transported by road in small quantities. Due to lockdown lack of road transport feasibility, Railways officials approached the consignors and facilitated the commodity by rail

CHENNAI PORT OFFERS NEW CONCESSIONS FOR COASTAL VESSELS



Chennai port Trust (ChPT) has modified the concessions

offered on vessel-related charges (VRC) for coastal vessels carrying coastal transshipment and ex-im-laden transshipment cargo,an upfront concession of 70 per cent in VRC will be offered to coastal vessels carrying 100 TEUs or more of ex-im transshipment containers per voyage & 50 per cent in VRC will be offered to coastal vessels carrying either 100 TEUs of coastal-laden transshipment containers or 100 TEUs of combined ex-im and coastal-laden transshipment.
