#### US IMPORT BOOM

- North America container gateways congestion to persist until summer as consumer-driven import boom continues.
- Apr new records 31% year-on-year growth in containerized imports to the US from Asia.
- 1.57m teu from Asia in Apr for 10th consecutive month.



#### **CONGESTION @ YICT**

- Severe congestion at Hutchison's Yantian International Container Terminal (YICT) in Shenzhen.
- This is due to delayed vessel schedules affecting terminal operations & causing traffic congestion.
- Only laden containers within 4 days of a vessel's estimated time of arrival would be accepted until 3 June.



## CU LINES - ASIA - EUROPE TRADE LIFELINE

- CU Lines confirmed upgrading its Asia-Europe service to fortnightly frequency to cater to demand surge.
- AEX port rotation is Shanghai-Ningbo-Xiamen-Nansha-Yantian-Cai Mep-Rotterdam-Hamburg-Antwerp-Shanghaideploying 4 vessels of between 2,700 - 4,400 teu.



## BANGLADESH - MANDATORY E PAYMENT FOR DUTIES

- Effective 1st January 2022, duties & charges of any amount must be paid electronically, affecting customs in airports, seaports & land ports.
- Bangladesh currently ranks at 168 out of 190 countries in ease of doing business, according to the World Bank.



#### X-PRESS PEARL BLAZE

- Sri Lanka's Marine Environment Protection Authority (MEPA) warned that the fire-stricken X-Press Pearl is about to sink, as efforts to control the blaze continues.
- Sri Lanka's army deployed to stop locals collecting increasing debris from containers lost overboard.
- 25 crew members are confirmed safe.



## CYCLONE TAUKTAE SHUTS PIPAVAV PORT

- Cyclone Tauktae caused Pipavav to shut till 1st June.
- No major damage to port infrastructure, but its power supply & communication links had been disrupted.
- Containerships diverted from 1.35m teu capacity facility.



# EVER GIVEN CASE REACHES HIGHER COURT

- The Ever Given case has reached a higher court, which is expected to hear claims on a further date.
- Japan's Shoei Kisen filed a \$100,000 compensation claim against the SCA for "losses related to its detention".
- However, the court in Ismailia rejected the appeal & upheld the SCA's detention of the vessel.

# HUNT FOR ALTERNATIVES TO COPE WITH REEFER SHORTAGE

- Constrained ocean capacity strain US perishables shippers.
- · Shortages of frozen, dehydrated & fresh potatoes.
- Shippers exploring alternatives through air shipments.
- However, shippers are experiencing 'sticker price shock' at current rates.



### CARGO THREE EYES US CARGO CHARTER SERVICES

- Cargo Three applied to the US Department of Transportation (DoT) offering cargo charter services.
- Using a 38-year old converted A300-B4, it will operate 5- 10 flights per week with an estimated capacity of 40 tons.
- The flights will be non-scheduled services operating between the US and Panama.



## NO BAN ON LITHIUM-ION BATTERIES - IATA

- Post Honk Kong fire due to Vivo phones, IATA said it began discussion, but did not support an outright ban.
- IATA does not plan to ban the transport of lithium ion batteries by air, but calls for greater penalties for errors & better collaboration with governments.



# AIR FRANCE - KLM OPERATE ON SAF

- Air France-KLM operated its 1st flight using French-made sustainable aviation fuel (SAF) made from waste sourced.
- In partnership with Airbus & fuel company Total, Air France used a 16% blend of SAF on a A350 flight from Paris to Montreal, avoiding the emission of 20 tons of CO2.



# BLUE DART AVIATION TO THE RESCUE

- Blue Dart Aviation did an optimal utilization of the Boeing 757-200 fleet on scheduled & charter operations of pharmaceutical, medical supplies & e-commerce demand.
- The airline's support towards the government's Lifeline Udan initiative had also helped boost volumes.



## SMARTLYNX BRINGS IN PASSENGER - FREIGHTERS

- SmartLynx Airlines to temporarily convert 5 A330 aircraft for freight operations, having a 'zero passenger' layout.
- Airbus operator SmartLynx, said the demand for long-haul cargo operations had driven it to grow its fleet & introduce the modified aircraft.

# EWB INTEGRATED WITH FASTAG & RFID

- GST officers are armed with real-time data of commercial vehicle movement on highways with integration of the eway bill (EWB) system with FasTag & RFID.
- This will help nab tax evaders who misuse the EWB.



HAZARDOUS CARGO LICENSE FOR LOX TRUCKS

- The Ministry of Road Transport & Highways stated that only trained drivers having 'hazardous cargo' license are allowed to operate the Liquid Oxygen (LOX) trucks.
- States & Union territories to make available 500 trained drivers & increase to 2500 in the next 2 months.



#### INNOVATING WITH PERFORMANCE BASED PRICING

Manufacturers were unable to maintain long term pricing as annual contracts with carriers were upheld. Hence a shift has been made to short-to-medium pricing solutions. Short-term pricing, dual-sourcing strategies & managing increased supply chain complexity are now "front and centre" for global ocean freight shippers.

It is expected that the industry is likely to lean on performance-based pricing, as performance-based contracts are more interesting paired with long-term agreements. Shippers suggest that quarterly review of performance and improvement strategies should be the basis for renewing contracts every 3 months. Thus, ridding the annual bid cycles.

With all the disruptions from Covid, Montreal port strikes, Suez Canal blockage, Lack of containers (Especially reefers), warehousing labour & capacity will now force shippers to innovate to focus on continuity planning.

# GMR STEPPING UP TO EASE COVID RELIEF

- GHAC has constituted a special task force comprising customs authorities, airlines & freight forwarders to ensure speedy clearance & handling of COVID relief material consignments.
- GMR Hyderabad Air Cargo (GHAC) expanded its landside & airside facilities to meet the unique requirements for vaccine shipments & temp-controlled pharmaceuticals.



#### **RECKLESS IRON-ORE EXPORTS**

- Reckless export of iron ore chokes the logistics facility in Odisha, threatening the survival of home metal firms.
- The incremental exports & drop in manufacturing has created a scarcity of iron ore in the nation and surged up the cost.



# DIRECT CONNECTIVITY TO WEST AFRICA - DP WORLD

- DP World added a new weekly "Far East West Africa India Express" service (FEW3) operated by Maersk Line.
- A fixed-weekly sailing will deploy 13 vessels of 4,500 to 5,500
  TEUs capacity, offering direct connectivity from West Africa to
  Cochin Port & from Cochin Port to Far East Ports.



BLR AIRPORT RECORD TONNAGE FOR COVID RELIEF MATERIAL

- Bengaluru (KIAB/ BLR Airport) has processed 650,225 kgs of COVID-19-related relief material from Apr 1 - May 19, 2021.
- The major import commodities were, Oxygen concentrators, ventilators & Zeolite while COVID-19 vaccines & PPEs were the top domestic inbound cargo.



RICE & WHEAT EXPORTS

- India is likely to harvest a record 121.46 million mt of rice in 2020-21, up 2.2% from 2020 Agriculture Ministry.
- Export prices of Indian rice may decline given record output.
- The Asian nation likely to see a record harvest of wheat at 108.75 million mt against 107.86 million mt (2020).
- Wheat export prices may not decline as increase in the production is marginal.


